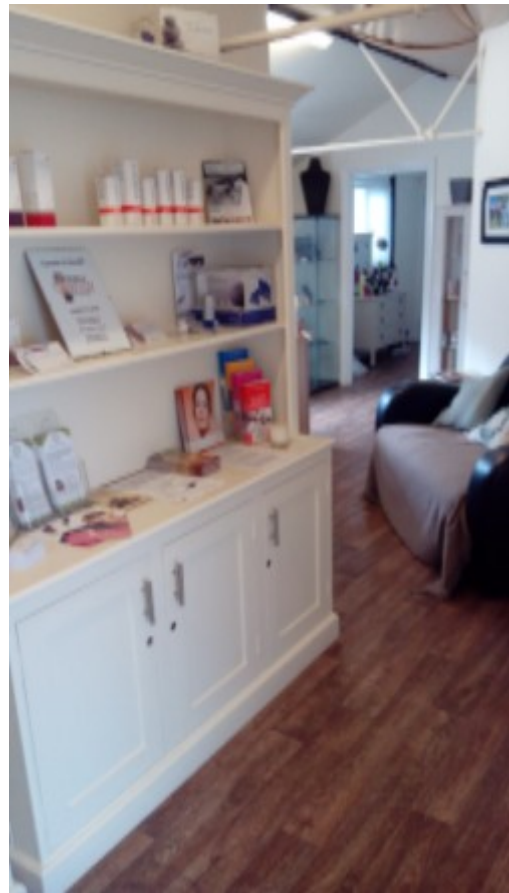


The [McNeill Gallery](#) in Market Place, Pewsey exhibits many leading contemporary artists, including the works of Hashim Akib.
