

Geocaching across the Vale of Pewsev

Geocaching is rapidly becoming a major outdoor pursuit, with more than an estimated 160,000 people in the UK taking part. There are more than 2.8 million Geocaches in more than 180 countries.

So what is Geocaching? It's an outdoor adventure activity where people use a mobile app or GPS to find the location of a hidden cache. The cache can be very small, containing just a paper log for you to register that you found it, or it could be a box hidden in a tree containing small gifts or perhaps it could be a hollow brick in a wall. Each one is different with a scale of difficulty depending on the imagination of the original geocache creator.

There is an army of individuals who put the geocaches in place - anyone can do it and the geocache can be anywhere that has public access. The geocache creator then just registers the geocache on geocaching.com and it's available for everyone to see.

Geocaching provides a way of exploring an area with friends and family and have a bit of fun. You can create a walking or cycling route from the Geocache website and it's a great day out.
