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
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Opportunities in October

Could the Vale of Pewsey become a Heritage Action Zone?

The Pewsey Community Area Partnership (PCAP) is investigating the possibility of the Vale of Pewsey becoming a Heritage Action Zone (HAZ) which is a scheme run by [Historic England](#). The HAZ status, if you are selected, provides an area

or town with access to funding, experts and other specialist skills and research in order to unlock the economic potential of the area. It is normally a 3 to 5 year project and requires the Local Authority (in our case, Wiltshire Council) to take the lead on the project. We understand that the next round of applications will take place in the spring of 2018. At the recent Pewsey Area Board, the proposal was supported and they voted in favour of it with Cllr Stuart Wheeler liaising.

It was therefore proposed that interested parties should be invited to an initial workshop to define the vision for the Vale of Pewsey and to identify the types of projects that would be required to fulfil that vision.

PCAP would therefore like to invite you to a **workshop on Tuesday 24th October 2017 from 7pm to 9pm**.

The venue will be in Pewsey or close by and will be confirmed at a later date.

In order to manage the event, we would be grateful if you could **let PCAP know whether you are able to attend by Tuesday 10th October 2017**.

Tourist Information Kiosks



You may remember the opening of the first Tourist Information Kiosk at Swan Corner in Pewsey earlier this year. Since then, our partners have had the benefit of advertising on the board and in the leaflet holders.

We now have an exciting programme of further Tourist Information Kiosks across the Vale, with the support of the Pewsey Area Board Grants and the Parish Councils. Coming up soon will be the phone box in Bottlesford, followed by planned installations in Upavon, Burbage and Great Bedwyn. Cossor's Shop in Pewsey will also be hosting an area in the shop for leaflets and advertisements and we have agreed with Great Western Railway to put leaflet holders and business card holders in the waiting rooms at Pewsey Station as well.

If you are already advertising in the Swan Corner phone box, then your adverts will be placed in the new installations. We may contact you if we need a smaller version of your advert and don't have the file.

If you don't already have an advert in the kiosk or you aren't sure, then please email susie@visitpewseyvale.co.uk who will be able to help you.

Business cards - if you would like your business cards displayed at Pewsey Station, then [email susie@visitpewseyvale.co.uk](mailto:email_susie@visitpewseyvale.co.uk) and we will arrange to collect them or ask you to post them to us. There is no facility at the station to have a noticeboard, so using a business card holder provides a similar function.
